Tri-Arrows Aluminum Announces New President

Tri-Arrows Aluminum, Inc., (Louisville, Kentucky) announced today that it will appoint Henry Gordinier as President effective January 18, 2016.

The company is a premier supplier of rolled aluminum sheet products produced at its jointly-owned rolling mill, Logan Aluminum, with capabilities and experience in ingot casting, hot rolling, cold rolling, and finishing operations. Mr. Gordinier worked for eight years with the Tri-Arrows predecessor, ARCO Aluminum Inc. He has an MBA from Vanderbilt University and a BA from Brown University.

The company began operations in 1977 as ARCO Aluminum. It was purchased by a consortium of Japanese companies on August 1, 2011, and has a growing international presence in conjunction with its Japanese owners, UACJ Corporation, Sumitomo Corporation, Itochu Corporation and Itochu Metals Corporation.

Over the past 30 years, Tri-Arrows has been a premier supplier of rolled aluminum sheet used in the production of beverage containers. Tri-Arrows recently announced investment of \$290 million to expand manufacturing capabilities for the emerging North American automotive aluminum sheet market and to increase overall plant capacity, including a new aluminum recycling/ingot casting facility.
